

# Texas Health Steps Quick Reference Guide Updated for June 2019

Information posted May 31, 2019

**Note:** *Texas Medicaid managed care organizations (MCOs) must provide all medically necessary, Medicaid-covered services to eligible clients. Administrative procedures such as prior authorization, pre-certification, referrals, and claims/encounter data filing may differ from traditional Medicaid (fee-for-service) and from MCO to MCO. Providers should contact the client's specific MCO for details.*

The Texas Health Steps Quick Reference Guide has been updated. The Cervarix-HPV2 vaccine is no longer available through the Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC) Program. The TVFC vaccine reference has been removed from procedure code 90650 listed in the "Immunizations Administered" column of the Texas Health Steps Quick Reference Guide.
